

Boulevard Baptist Christian School Dress Code

General

A. It is expected of our boys and girls to dress neatly and modestly as a part of our Christian testimony. These dress standards apply to all students whether attending classes or school activities. Visitors must also comply. **Anything the administration considers extreme in hairstyles, dress, or general appearance for boys or girls will not be permitted.** *I Corinthians 6:19, 20.* Student's dress must reflect the Christian character of the school. Parents must be in agreement with our regulations before their child is admitted.

B. Students that come to school dressed inappropriately will not be allowed to attend class until the proper dress code is adhered to. In the event a student's shirt does not comply with dress code regulation a school shirt will be provided to the student and parents will be charged for the cost of the shirt. No exceptions will be made for dress code violations.

C. Shoes must be worn at all times. Tennis shoes, if neat and clean, are permitted except on Wednesdays. Shirts with suggestive logos or lettering (i.e. beer commercials, singers or singing groups other than religious, attitude, vulgar or suggestive language, or suggestive ideas will not be allowed). The principal must approve any shirts with emblems, pictures, or lettering before being worn to school. No excessively baggy, fad, or cult clothing will be permitted.

D. No body piercing will be allowed except girls earlobes.

Parents

BBCS meets in a church building. Please do not come inside the school / church building wearing inappropriate clothing.

Boys

A. Haircuts must be a conservative, moderate style. No faddish haircuts (chili bowl, partially shaved, etc.) or bleached/streaked hair will be allowed. Hair must be tapered, must not hang over collar, ears, or eyebrows. Hair must be one finger width above a buttoned dress shirt collar. No sideburns may extend below the middle of the earlobes, no mustaches or beards. No student may comb his hair in class. Boys will be checked for hair length every Wednesday. If hair is too long, a note will go home to parents. The boy must have a haircut before being admitted to class on the following Monday.

B. Shirts must be buttoned all the way except the top collar button. Shirts must be long enough when hands are raised above the head the bottom of the shirt comes below the top of jeans or pants. Shirt- tails (button up shirts only) must be tucked in at all times, except during PE. No sleeveless shirts are permitted.

C. No necklaces, earrings, or feminine looking attire are permitted.

D. Boys are permitted to wear sandals (except on Wednesday) with or without socks.

E. Boys are permitted to wear jeans and slacks only (except for P.E.).

Girls

A. Hemlines must touch the floor when in an upright kneeling position. No tight clothing (shirts, dresses, or tops) will be allowed.

B. No slacks, jeans, shorts, sundresses, razor shirts, tank tops, wrap around skirts, tube tops or form fitting tops (must be have 1" of loose fabric and must be one hand length below the waist).will be permitted. Necklines may measure no lower than three finger's width below the joining of the collarbones under the neck. Only the collar button on all blouses and dresses may be left unbuttoned. Girls must wear proper undergarments at all times. Sweaters and blouses with excessively large armholes may not be worn unless another blouse (within acceptable dress code) is worn under it.

C. Sleeveless shirts may be worn only if undergarments are not showing or does not resemble a tank top. Shirts or blouses must be long enough when hands are raised above the head the bottom of the shirt or blouse comes below the top of culottes or skirts. Skirts with splits may only be worn if the slit begins below the knee.

D. During cold weather girls may wear tights or leggings under their culottes. No pajamas, lounge pants, or jeans may be worn under culottes.

E. No flip flops may be worn at any time. Sandals are permitted.

F. Girls may wear culottes to class, but will receive a check if they do not sit modestly. **Culottes must look like a skirt. Culottes that look like shorts or gauchos will not be allowed.** Modesty is our goal.

G. Repeated checks may result in a ban on culottes for that girl. Culottes may not be worn on Chapel Day.

H. Girls may not apply makeup or nail polish during class time, lunch period, or breaks. No girl should loan make-up, hairbrushes, or combs to others. No student may comb her hair in class. Hair must be in a moderate style. No gothic make-up or nail polish will be allowed (example: dark blue or black).
